

## **Rules**

**Scoring** – This is a team scramble event, which means everyone hits a tee shot and the team plays from the best shot location of all the drives. Teams may move the ball one club length from the selected shot, but the ball must remain in the same state (in the fairway, in the rough, in the sand) you cannot improve the state of the ball. Then everyone hits the next shot and the team plays from that best shot location and so forth until the ball is in the cup. If after all 4 players have hit and there is an undesirable result, anyone can use one "mulligan" and hit another shot. A mulligan can only be used once. Everyone received one mulligan with their golf registration. Players may purchase up to 2 additional mulligans at registration for \$10 each.

\*\***The worst score a team can take is a bogey** – or one over par. If the team score is equal to par for that hole and the ball is not in the cup, you do not have to putt out for a bogey score. Just pick up the ball and move on to the next hole.

Each team must record their hole score on the scorecard after each hole and then turn in the scorecard after finishing the round.

**Spirits Putting Contest** – Every golfer receives a green ticket for one putt. The contest will be held on the putting green closest to the Par-Take/Starter building. Each golfer will be putting at a bottle of Spirits of their choice. If their ball hits the bottle, they win the bottle (only one bottle per putt) or select a prize. Your name will be written on the bottom of the bottle, or prize, you can then pick up the bottle during lunch. No bottles may be taken out on the course during play. Contest is from 7:00 A.M. till 7:50 A.M., then as teams come to 8th Tee, players may putt during play, while supplies last. You may purchase more tickets for \$10.

**Closest to Pin Contests** – After hitting first tee shot <u>on the green</u>, measure distance from the hole and write on marker. **Cannot use** a mulligan for closest to pin prize, ball must land on the green.

**Longest Drive Contest** – Place name on marker after hitting initial drive in the fairway. Cannot use mulligan for longest drive.
