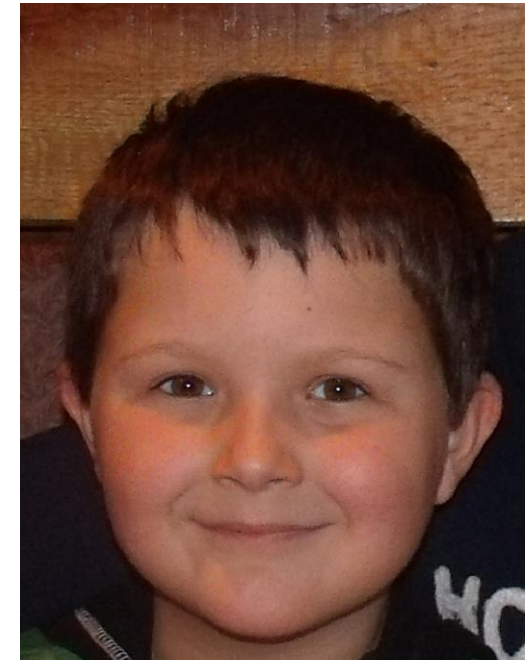

# About The Event

The Sixth Annual Jordan Smelski Foundation Golf Tournament is held in memory of Jordan Smelski.

Jordan passed away on July 2, 2014 to primary amoebic meningoencephalitis (PAM). He was 11 years old. Jordan contracted the amoeba *Naegleria fowleri* from swimming in hot springs in Costa Rica while on vacation. PAM is 99% fatal, yet 100% preventable.

\*All proceeds go toward amoeba awareness, training, and research. The Jordan Smelski Foundation partnered with AdventHealth for Children to present the 4<sup>th</sup> Amoeba Summit, and once again funding research with Virginia Commonwealth University in 3 specific areas related to *Naegleria fowleri* and funded research with the CDC for an early detection test for possible PAM cases.
